CALL TO ORDER: Colleen called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m.

OLD BUSINESS: None

SECRETARY REPORT (Verna McNabb) Minutes were approved as printed.

VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT (Adrian Fox) Adrian reported there are enough door prizes for the July meeting. She will be attending the upcoming shop hop and will try to obtain more from the area quilt shops.

TREASURER'S REPORT (Dianne Bauman): Cash on hand is \$5081.40, which does not include our savings account or revenues from the quilt show. Dianne will be sending a donation to McFarlin for the use of the building.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Donation Quilts (Wilma DeBerry) In Wilma's absence, Anne Watkins reports there will be no community quilts work day in June. CCFI (Centers for Children and Families, Inc.) wants to include the abused toddlers in the donation quilt program. The board noted they can distribute our donations to any of their agency subgroups as desired.

Ways and Means (Margaret Decker) Margaret reported she will complete the sorting of the storage area in readiness for the quilt show. A total of \$97.40 was sold at the May meeting. She will forward an article to Ruth for placement in the next newsletter to solicit magazines and any other quilt-related items for the Ways and Means booth at the quilt show. Also mentioned was the Centennial quilt top will be auctioned in July.

Membership (Janet Bronston): No report.

Programs (Theresa Duval): Theresa reported Nita Beshear will be the guest speaker at the July guild meeting. Nita is from SE Oklahoma and has written *Devoted to Quilting*. She has several topics from which to choose, and the Board directed Theresa to ask her for either of the ones that were the more humorous from her list. Also noted is that Nancy Shepherd-Green will be our guest speaker in August.

Newsletter (Ruth Leidy): Ruth suggested sending out the newsletter a few days later than usual and closer to the monthly meetings to help remind members of the programs and monthly events. The next newsletter will have directions to the Rose State auditorium for the Ami Sims program on June 15th at 7:00 p.m. as well as information about the all-day workshop at Quilter's Corner in Midwest City

for those signed up to attend this class. It was also suggested she have a reminder of where to drop off quilts for the July show and the deadline for getting the show quilts to these locations.

Quilt Show Committee: (Anne Watkins): Anne reported there is \$6000 in the bank and more revenue coming in from raffle ticket sales. The Stitching Post is giving us three sewing machines - two for door prizes and one for their choice of best quilt in the show. Fun to Sew has donated a fabric mover (table) and Prairie Quilts (one of the show sponsors) has donated an embellisher. There has been a good turnout of donations for the show.
